Admission Requirements for the Master of Science in Health Informatics and Information Management Program

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Official transcripts from colleges and universities attended</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• An earned undergraduate degree from an accredited institution and completion of the following prerequisite courses within five years of application: computer programming (3 semester hour minimum) and statistics (3 semester hour minimum); experience with Java programming preferred for thesis and nonthesis options.</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• An undergraduate grade point average (GPA) of 3.00 or better</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Acceptable scores on the verbal, quantitative, and analytical sections of the GRE or GMAT</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Three letters of recommendation</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Personal statement: A statement of purpose outlining the goals for pursuing a graduate education in health informatics and information management</li></ul>
